## Gear Up for Bike Month



May is National Bike Month, your chance to discover the joys of commuting by bike. Here's what's happening...

### Throughout Southern California

Ride Metrolink for free during Bike to Work Week, May 13-17, **when you bring your bike on board.**

### In Los Angeles County

- **Win Prizes:** Log your bike commute trips at [ridematch.info](http://ridematch.info) throughout May for a chance to win prizes including Aventon e-bikes, a commuter bicycle, tool kits, helmets and more.
