Metrolink's Summer Day Pass is just \$15 for unlimited systemwide travel any day Monday through Friday.

It's available through Aug. 30 via the **Metrolink mobile app** and at ticket machines.

## Ride RTA for 25 Cents—Plus Youth Ride Free

Now through Aug. 31, you can ride Riverside Transit Agency (RTA) buses for only 25 cents. The discount rate applies on all fixed-route buses and GoMicro shuttles every day, including weekends.

Also, starting July 1, youth 18 and under can ride RTA buses for free.
