More Free Rides and Discounts

Veterans Ride Free: U.S. military veterans as well as active military can ride Ventura County buses for free on Nov. 11.

To qualify for a free ride, veterans should show their valid veteran's identification to the bus driver upon boarding any participating fixed-route bus service.

Veterans without proper identification may be asked to share their branch, dates and location of service with the bus driver.



Holiday Fares: Ride Metrolink for \$10 all day on Thanksgiving Day, Christmas and New Year's Day. Trains will run on their Sunday schedule so consult metrolinktrains.com for schedule information.
